

What Can You Do With A 4x2?

Owing to the difficulty of producing enough pieces of Camphor Laurel of the required dimensions, it has been decided to change the wood type to Pine therefore a quantity of 4 x 2 framing has been purchased.

The idea of the competition is to take a piece of $100 \times 50 \times 2400$ and use it alone to produce a single item .

At the judging at our Expo on July 2nd, points will be awarded for Creativity, Design, Workmanship and Efficient use of timber.





The entry fee is the cost of the timber when we calculate it.

And the first prize is a 12 month subscription to Australian Wood Review.

Timber will be available at The Shed from Monday 21st.


A Note from Brian Holdsworth......
