Wood Wizz - New bearings and brushes are to be fitted along with new field windings as the previous were found to be badly burnt due to over heating. All will be up and running as soon as possible, I am waiting for the windings to come from Makita in N.S.W.

2/5 New tubes fitted to the tyres on the sack trolley. They should stay inflated now.

This Month's Safety Report.

Bandsaw Operation - Please take special care when you decide to crosscut a small log on one of the bandsaws. Natural variations in the log will mean in many cases that it will not be in safe contact with the bandsaw table and it may wobble as you cut. This may lead to a blade jam and a blade break.

The blade may also catch and try to tumble even a perfectly round log.



A "V" jig is available to make small round pieces more stable, but care must always be exercised. If you are in any doubt, please ask the shed captain of

the day for assistance. He or she will be happy to help you.

Last Saturday the final adjustments were made to our new Slabbing Bandsaw and a test cut was made.




